Route Plan infringements

Not correctly filled up

Missing Section 1

- Date and time of arrival
- Total estimated weight
- Stocking density
- Planned route not filled in

Section 2

Signature of the organiser

Section 4 not filled up during the journey.

Physical problems with truck

Individual stalls for horses, not separated by sex. Don't comply for long or short journies

Physical problems, broken locks etc

Long journey should be two drivers,

Journey on tachograph already greater than 8 hours.

Not offered water

Additional information

Horses are overstocked 16 horses in 18M squared.

821 kms journey, requires 22 hours minimum with 1 driver

Does he have a navigation system

No records of temperature etc

Looks like he has an internal height problem from the photos, needs 75cms from the withers.

Actions

What do we do

Catch the horse that is loose

Veterinary inspection for horse to ensure that it is fit for transport

Need new vehicle to transport horse that has escaped.,

Check that there is a contingency plan for emergency.

Bring to the closest place of unloading or

If truck can be secured then bring them to their place of destination if it close, what is the best result for the animals. 44kms to final destination so this might be best solution
