Infringements

The vehicle is not authorized for long transports and the transporter doesn't have the authorisation for long journey.

- 2) Not emergency plan for journey-
- 3) Horses must be separated from the pregnant pony and it isn't
- 4) Two horses without traces health certificates
- 5) Stallions are with pregnant females
- 6) Stallions must be separated between them
- 7) Section 5 is missing
- 8) There is no journal plan
- 9) Seeing the pictures, we saw that animals were tied

Passports of all horses

Check navigation data

Registers of temperature

BTSF

Actions

Unload animals in the control post.

Separate animal that must be separated

Rest for minum time of 24 hours

Ask for passport of animals and health certificates for two horses

Ask for a new lorry whit authorization

Inform local authority of origin country
