DEPAR TNAVES, FRANCE
DESTINATION ITALY :

JOURNEY TIME 19 HOURS

TYPE OF VEHICLE (TRACTOR /TRAILER, TWO DECKS EACH)

TEMPERATURE 22 DEG C

EMERGENCY CONTROL POINT STOPPED THE TRUCK FOR A ROUTINE CHECK

CARE OF ANIMALS AT CHECKPOINT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPETENT
AUTHORITY

Infringements

WHAT INFRINGEMENTS?

- 1) VEHICLE- ONLY SHORT JOURNEY AUTHORISATION
- 2) DRINKING DEVICES INADEQUATE-CATTLE CAN'T DRINK "suitable drinking devices"
- 3) 32 ANIMALS IS ok ON ONE DECK,
- 4) INSUFFICIENT INFORMATION FOR THE JOURNEY PLAN- NOT REALISTIC BECAUSE NO TIME ALLOWED FOR UNLOADING. Timings at destination are wrong on journey plan

WHAT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS NECESSARY?

More information about the drinking system and the water tank-capacity,
Check that the drinkers are working, check for leaks

Actions

- 1) REAL PROBLEM IS THAT THE VEHICLE IS NOT AUTHORISED FOR THIS JOURNEY
 - 2) VEHICLE IS STOPPED UNTIL THE FINE IS PAID
 - 3) ANIMALS CAN BE MOVED TO WATER QUICKLY IF NECESSARY
 - 4) SEND REPORT TO NATIONAL CONTACT POINT, (attaching all documentation)
- (DRIVERS HOURS ALSO A PROBLEM, NOT A VETERINARY PROBLEM)
